OUR STUDENTS

EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION

St Mark's offers excellence in primary school education through a broad and holistic teaching and learning program, underpinned by the Australian Curriculum.

Our nine key areas of learning are: English, Mathematics, Science, Humanities and Social Sciences, Health and Physical Education, the Arts, Technologies, German and Christian Studies.

An inquiry approach to learning develops students' knowledge and skills in a partnership with their teachers as they become active in constructing learning pathways to provide foundations that will support their lifelong learning.

LEARNING FOR THE FUTURE

Our students learn from an early age how to access and use the technologies that are shaping our rapidly changing world. Students adopt the basics of Technology from their first year and we balance traditional learning methods with new tools, techniques and technologies to best equip them for life and learning in our digital age.

All learning areas across our school and curriculum are supported by access to our extensive school-provided technology resources.

Our flexible learning spaces and ongoing facility upgrades ensure our students have access to modern classrooms that facilitate their learning and growth.



EXPLORE, PLAY, GROW

Through the inquiry process for learning, our students are encouraged to explore all areas of the curriculum and develop their natural sense of curiosity.

Students gain essential skills to locate, select, organise and communicate information to others. They learn how to analyse, interpret, synthesize and evaluate information through reading, writing, viewing and listening – and develop as critical thinkers and problem solvers.

We incorporate lots of fun into our curriculum to encourage learning through play, games, creativity, interactive tasks and excursions.



We recognise that each child is unique – that's why our students are provided with personalised support and guidance to assist with their learning as required.

We welcome children with learning needs requiring support plans and their families as valued members of our St Mark's family. We offer in-classroom assistance to allow students to work individually or in small groups with specialist teachers and support staff.

Our passionate teachers also work with students seeking learning extension opportunities to further accelerate their academic growth.

MUSIC AND THE ARTS

Our comprehensive school-based Music program provides children with the experience of learning a musical instrument with private tutors who visit St Mark's. Our students also enjoy performance opportunities through the Junior Singing Groups, Senior Choir, Senior Band and St Mark's Concert Program.

As part of our Arts approach, students develop their creativity through programs and initiatives in dance, drama and visual arts.





OUTDOOR EDUCATION

Students explore outdoor education through classroom programs including camps, excursions, and school-sponsored activities including dance and swimming instruction. Our playgrounds, sports facilities and nature play spaces provide plenty of planned and spontaneous activity and fun.

We encourage our students to pursue active lives and we support their passion for sport by promoting participation at all levels, including interschool competition.

Our students are given the opportunity to attend the full range of opportunities available in the SAPSASA program, Lutheran Schools Athletics Champion Challenge, Pedal Prix and local and state sporting clubs coaching clinics.

SOCIAL JUSTICE

We strive to develop a social justice perspective in our students. Through our association with local, national and global organisations and charities our students come to a better appreciation of the world around them and how they are called to selflessly serve others.

Students participate in acts of service for their peers and the wider community and provide input into choosing causes to support.



BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

STUDENT WELLBEING

Our students are at the heart of all we do at St Mark's, so we go above and beyond to prioritise their wellbeing. We support our students by providing:

- Peer Mentoring Program to connect students of all ages to build positive relationships across year levels throughout the school community.
- Seasons for Growth Program to support and guide students who have experienced grief or challenging life changes. Students are provided with a safe space to share their experience, while also learning effective, evidence-based ways to respond and adapt.
- Behaviour Education Policy based on Restorative Justice Practices – to sensitively and effectively manage behavioural issues including bullying, while also developing students' critical skills to learn to restore peace in their relationships.
- Individual Support our Religious Pastoral Support Worker plays a pivotal role in supporting students and their families through life's ups and downs and is accessible for students during the school week.
- The Hub a calm, well-equipped break-out space designed to provide children with a quiet, sensory-friendly place in which they can feel calm, safe
- Care Program our Class Carers and Care Program provide additional support to families experiencing challenging times.
- **KidsHope** one-to-one mentoring program



EXTRA EXPERIENCES

At St Mark's we focus on educating the whole child by providing a range of experiences. In addition to our Outdoor Education, Social Justice and Music Programs we offer:

- Student leadership opportunities including House Captains, School Captains and Student Representative Council members
- School performances including our biennial whole-school musical

- School Assembly and Chapel services with student input
- Church services at St Mark's Lutheran Church

OUTSIDE SCHOOL HOURS CARE

We are proud to offer an on-site fun and flexible Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) program.

Our private OSHC provider partner offers a reliable, engaging and hassle-free service that is centred on child enrichment and care. Their engaged educators foster a safe, inclusive environment where children can relax, have fun and grow. Options include before and after school care, as well as holiday care.

VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

Volunteers play an important role in supporting the learning, social connection and wellbeing of our teachers and students and add to the richness and diversity of our St Mark's community.

Our parent volunteers are highly respected and enjoy a range of opportunities to be involved in school life, from classroom and learning assistance to assisting with our social and community events, and being part of our Parents and Friends (P&F) group.



At St Mark's we prioritise each child's sense of belonging as part of our community. We work with families to ensure their children feel safe, supported and connected to their peers and their school environment so they have the confidence to engage better in their learning.

We offer a comprehensive transition program for our new Foundation students that includes:

- Four informal meet and play sessions at our school where children can meet each other, explore our facilities and get to know our teachers and Principal;
- Two formal visits in a classroom setting to familiarise students with their teacher and the classroom environment;
- A Parent Information Evening to guide new school parents in how they can support their child's learning and opportunities for families to become involved in school life;
- Partnerships with local kindergartens and Early Learning Centres where our staff meet with educators and new students before their first school year;
- Assigning each Foundation child a Year 6 Buddy who will support, mentor and guide them through their first year at St Mark's.

We also welcome families on our Student Led and Principal's Tours.
